The **Summer Experience Initiative** provides opportunities for students 16-21 years of age with an intellectual disability the opportunity to spend a week with the Conservation Youth Corps program. The week involves fun, learning and hard work!

You will be part of a integrated crew of students with your own crew leader. You will get picked up at a designated location in the morning and dropped off in the afternoon at the spot, Monday through Friday.

It's a great week! Monday will be an orientation and team-building day; Tuesday to Friday will be work days. You will be working in Conservation Parks and public lands in your community.

Examples of work tasks can include: building and maintaining trails and fencing, building bird boxes, and creating habitat structures. All training and tools will be provided.

It won't be all work. Volunteers will enjoy opportunities for fun and exploration too!

\*Please note there may be a few days when the Conservation program is not running. Those days will be filled with other volunteer work and fun activities.

**Summer Experience Criteria**

1. Students must be between the ages of 14 – 21 years of age.
2. Students must be returning to school in September 2016.
3. Students must exhibit the potential to work and engage in recreational activities with minimal supervision.
